SUBJECT: 2024 TROUT STOCKING NOTICE DATE: 11 MAR 2024 MEMORANDUM FOR: Christopher Remillard, MWR Recreation Officer

- 1. The distribution of trout stocking for the 2024-2025 Fishing Season is listed below. With regards to the season's start, as listed in the 2023-2024 West Point Fishing Notice, fishing for all trout (in both lakes/stream and brooks/creeks), begins on 01 APR after a no fishing period from 25 MAR 01 APR.
- 2. Private stocking of trout in 2024 shall remain constant with a repetition of 2023 in numbers of total trout by species and location as listed below. As in 2023, in 2024 in addition to the listed numbers below several larger trophy-size trout will be stocked in Bull Pond, Lusk Reservoir, & Round Pond.
- 3. State stocking of trout in 2024 shall remain constant with the NYSDEC opting to the stock same overall numbers fish by species in each location as was stocked at West Point in 2023.
- 4. Private stocking of brook trout, brown trout and rainbow trout will tentatively occur on 27 MAR and 17 APR. State stocking of brook trout and brown trout will occur on 15 APR. Natural Resources will accept stocking volunteers once again in 2024. See below.
- 5. Channel catfish will also be stocked in Mine Lake and Lake Frederick. Fathead minnows will be stocked in Lake Frederick and Round Pond as an additional forage base for game fish species. Since 2021, fall stocking of tiger musky has been and remains suspended due to state stocking shortages.
- 6. Anglers are reminded that to fish at West Point, any angler 16 years old and older requires a valid 1) NYS fishing license. All anglers also are required to have a valid 2) West Point fishing permit or be a guest in presence of a West Point permitted angler who also has a valid West Point Guest Pass.
- 7. Anglers are strongly encouraged to report their harvest on iSportsman. Although harvest report is not required for fishing as it is with hunting, harvest reporting does help Natural Resources better understand and manage our fishery. To report, simply sign in to an area and report harvest at check-out.
- 8. In 2024, West Point will once again accept volunteers. Those interested should email Christopher Killough at <u>Christopher.w.killough3.civ@army.mil</u>. Response emails closer to stocking will confirm meeting time and place.
