**** LICENSE & PERMIT REQUIREMENTS: To trap any land or water at West Point, all trappers need an active 1) NYS Trapping License and 2) West Point Trapping Permit (No Guest Trapping is permitted at West Point).**

WEST POINT TRAPPING PROGRAM

Trapping on West Point is limited to eleven (11) total trapping permits, with each permit holder being assigned an individual trapping area on a first-come-first-served basis. In order to purchase a West Point trapping permit, an individual must first visit the DPW/NRB office in person, at which time that individual will:

1. Complete and sign a trapping authorization form,
2. Be assigned their trapping area, and
3. Be issued a hard-copy trapping map.

An individual will then be given a Trapping Authorization validation on their iSportsman account and be able to purchase their trapping permit online on WestPoint.iSportsman, completing the permitting process

**** NO UNAUTHOTIZED STOCKING OF FISH/WILDLIFE OR PLANTS ** The stocking of any fish or wildlife or release/planting of any non-native plants is prohibited at West Point.**

*** NOTE ON BOBCAT, OTTER, & FISHER

*** River Otter, bobcat, and fisher trapping areas and harvest must be specifically authorized in advance by DPW – Natural Resource Branch Staff.

**** COMPLIANCE WITH NYS REGULATIONS: For species not listed, New York State regulations apply. All West Point regulations shall comply with New York State regulations insofar as West Point restrictions may compliment but shall not violate New York State regulations.**
