

2025 WEST POINT HUNTING MAP CHANGES NOTICE

As of September 17, 2025, a new West Point Hunting Map replaces the 2019 version and all previous maps. This is the map to be used in the field, although the changes are localized mostly to Areas L, Q, & R. The Natural Resources Section is working with iSportsman to update the interactive hunting map accordingly. Specific map changes are detailed below.

- 1) **Areas L, Q, R & new Off-Limits Area.** In 2024, West Point acquired a new ~85-acre tract. A new Off-Limits Area (closed to training and hunting) was made from this new tract and small parts of old Areas L and R with new boundaries shifting to nearby drainages, now posted with signage. Hunters must stay out of this area. Area Q's SW tip now ends at the RR21-RR24 Jct.

- 2) **Constitution Island Cadet Bow Area.** In 2025, Constitution Island is being retired as a hunting area due to a combination of factors including scarce use, complexity and difficulty in managing access and protection of natural and cultural resources. It also helps further simplify the hunting map, hunting program and island management.

Where can I get a copy of the new hunting map?

Digital PDF copies of the new hunting map will soon be available on iSportsman for users to 1) print out (set to fit 8.5x11 paper) or 2) download and use with an off-line phone app.

Natural Resources Section is currently working with iSportsman to make these hunting map edits to the Interactive Map, but it may take time before this change is made.

Large field maps are usually printed following map changes, but large maps will not be this year due to 1. small, local nature of changes and 2. likely additional edits to map in 2026.
